TEXAS WINE TRAILS®

Texas allows the wine tourist to enjoy the beauty of the Lone Star State while tasting delicious wine along these eight wine trails. The trails are named after geologic features or historic icons in Texas, and each connects a handful of wineries together for you to visit without feeling rushed. These trails explore each region of Texas, from the beaches in the south, the piney woods in the east, the quaint Old World towns in the beautiful Hill Country, to the rugged landscapes in West Texas.



TRAIL NAMES

Balcones Trail in central Texas, **Brazos Trail** in southeast Texas, **Enchanted Trail** in central Texas, **Highland Trail** in central Texas, **Munson Trail** in northeast Texas, **Palo Duro Trail** in northwest Texas, **Pecos Trail** in southwest Texas, and the **Tarantula Trail** in northeast Texas.

WINERIES

There are currently 50+ wineries in Texas. The largest concentrations of wineries are in the Hill Country and northeast Texas between Dallas and the Red River. The majority of vineyards, however, are in West Texas, where climate and a relatively pest free environment allow the grapes to thrive.
